All scholarships will be deposited in Smart Program #8718

All entrants must be current USBC Youth Division members. Must show proof of payment if <a href="www.bowl.com">www.bowl.com</a> does not show the membership processed for the 2024/2025 season by the time the scholarships are finalized. Doubles must consist of two boys, two girls, or one boy and one girl.

The tournament is divided into six divisions which are based on combined averages for doubles and individual averages for singles.

DOUBLES Open: 380+, Class A 301-379, Class B 300 & below SINGLES Open: 190+, Class A 151-189, Class B 150 & Below,

Entering average will be the highest **2023/2024** book average of 21 games or more including spring/summer leagues. If no 2023/2024 winter book average, use a spring/summer league average of 21 games or more which is not in the average book or your highest current average as of October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2024 with a minimum of 12 games. If there is still no average you will use 190. Bring a verified average at the time of bowling or send with multiple entries. The bowler, coach or league official is responsible for making sure the highest average (including traveling leagues) is used. A team or bowler could be subject to disqualification if incorrect averages are submitted. **If using last year's average and your average cannot be verified on www.bowl.com, you must mail league verification with entry form or bring when you bowl.** 

A bowler may enter more than once, but may only place once for doubles scholarships with the same partner and place only once for singles scholarships. Plaques/Scholarships will be awarded to one in every five teams or individuals in each division.

Handicap will be 90% of the difference between the team average, and 380 for doubles, and 190 for singles. There will be no handicap in the open divisions.

Scholarships will be awarded per division, based on the number of entries per division. At least one scholarship per division will be awarded. Scholarship winners will receive a certificate.

Scores cannot be combined from different entries. Scholarships will be deposited in the SMART Program.

Brackets will be available at \$5 per bracket, paying 1st and 2nd in Scholarships, which will be deposited in Smart.

#### Brackets will be handicapped at 220.

A pin will be awarded for your 1st 250 game of the day.

Award will be given to those who bowl a game of 50 or more pins over average.

\$20 per event, \$20 singles/ 3 games, \$40 doubles /3 games each

(\$11.00 bowling fee / \$1.35 awards / .65 expenses / \$7. Scholarship) = \$20.00 entry

WALK IN's: \$5 Late Processing fee added to FIRST entry only - \$25 SINGLES OR \$50 DOUBLES

Refunds only at the discretion of the tournament director.

No confirmations will be sent. You will only receive an email or phone call if your first choice is not available. Email reservations will be accepted.

Walk IN's will be accepted.... IF there are openings. **Note extra cost for walk-ins first time of participation only.** 

Bowlers are required to check in at least 30 minutes prior to scheduled shift time. Bowlers not present at the scheduled time will be permitted to bowl starting in the current frame being bowled. Zero for all frames missed. Failure to appear for scheduled time forfeits the reservation and entry fee. The tournament manager reserves the right to declare an emergency due to weather or conditions beyond our control.

If you have a large group it is advisable to bring balls and shoes from your bowling center. It is impossible to have a supply for all. No USBC banned bowling balls may be used in this tournament.

Any rules not covered here will be referred to the USBC Rule Book.

Not responsible for INJURY or LOSS of personal items.

Number of entries will determine the number of scholarship payouts

Rule 400 & Rule 319 Averages - will apply (10 pin rule will not apply)
