

TWIN CITIES UNITED STATES BOWLING CONGRESS (USBC) YOUTH ALL CITY TEAM CRITERIA

Eligibility

All USBC Youth certified bowlers that have bowled in a USBC youth certified winter league at a center within the jurisdiction of the Twin Cities USBC Youth are eligible provided that they bowl at least **two-thirds of the games bowled** by the league and that they carry a **minimum average: 190 for males and 165 for females.** There will be separate All City teams for males and females. All scores turned in must be accompanied by supporting documentation (example: year end league sheets). Bowlers will accumulate points during the current bowling season as follows:

Point System

Leagues

Points will be awarded to the top five averages in all USBC Youth certified leagues in the Twin Cities. Points will be awarded based on finish position with a maximum of 10 points combined from all leagues allowed for league participation: 10 points for first; 8 points for second; 6 points for third; 4 points for fourth and 2 points for fifth (10-8-6-4-2).

Twin Cities Youth Tournament

Points will be awarded to the bowlers with the top five scratch totals in each division, males and females, in the Youth Championships Tournament. Points will be awarded on the following basis: 10 points for first; 8 points for second; 6 points for third; 4 points for fourth and 2 point for fifth (10-8-6-4-2).

Youth Open Doubles & Singles Tournament (sponsored by the Twin Cities Youth Leaders)

Points will be awarded to the bowlers with the top five scratch totals in each division (singles and doubles), males and females, in the Youth Open Doubles & Singles Tournament. Points will be awarded on the following basis: 10 points for first; 8 points for second; 6 points for third; 4 points for fourth and 2 point for fifth (10-8-6-4-2).

Minnesota State USBC Youth Tournament (Team, Doubles & Singles)

Points will be awarded to the bowlers with the top five scratch totals in each division (team, singles and doubles), males and females, in the Minnesota State USBC Tournament. Points will be awarded on the following basis: 5 points for first; 4 points for second; 3 points for third; 2 points for fourth and 1 point for fifth (5-4-3-2-1).

Honor Scores

Points will be awarded for each high scratch score bowled in Twin Cities USBC Youth certified leagues and Twin Cities USBC Youth All City tournament competitions. Points will be awarded as follows:
