#### 1. ELIGIBILITY

### All bowlers must be ADULT members of the Twin Cities USBC Bowling Association.

Bowlers from other associations must purchase local membership \$10.00 (plus \$3.00 State fees if applicable). Associate membership will be available for purchase (\$28.00)

Failure to have membership shall result in disqualification and forfeiture of all entry fees and prize winnings.

#### 2. AVERAGES

### Highest Standard or Adjusted Challenge/ Sport League Average Shall Be Used

All <u>certified</u> averages will be used, based on the following sequence:

- A. The highest 2022-23 average (any association) based on a minimum of 21 games.
  - (Regardless of season Winter or Summer) (Regardless of hand – Left, Right, or Both)
- B. The highest current certified league average as of the first date of participation, based on a minimum of **21** games.
- C. All others will use a 220 scratch average.
- D. All PBA/PWBA members will bowl scratch

#### Rule 319D & Rule 319E will be in effect for all bowlers.

It shall be bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of their average. Failure to use the proper average or make corrections prior to or at time of bowling shall disqualify score if the submitted average is lower than actual average or base prize winnings on the submitted average if it is higher.

Averages that are not on BOWL.COM will not be considered unless a signed affidavit from the bowler's league secretary is provided. Without this affidavit such bowlers will participate at scratch.

#### **CURRENT AVERAGE 10 PIN RULE IS IN EFFECT!**

When the previous season's average is used and an entrant has a current season average for 21 games or more, as of the date of FIRST participation, that is ten (10) pins or more higher than the previous season's average, the current average must be used.

#### 6. PARTICIPATION

<u>Team Event</u> – Bowl as often as you wish with a change of at least TWO players.

Bowler's first score in the Team Event shall be used for their All Events.

No more than 1 PBA/ PWBA members per team

Singles & Doubles – Bowl only ONCE.
Bowlers must bowl in both Singles and Doubles.
Doubles will be bowled first followed by singles.
No more than 1 PBA/PWBA member per Doubles Team

All 6 games of the singles and doubles event will be bowled on the same pair of lanes for this event.

#### 7. SUBSTITUTIONS

Lineups as submitted on entry blank must be adhered to, unless notification is received 48 hours prior to competition. A substitute must bowl in the position vacated. Scores bowled through the efforts of more than one person will not qualify for any special individual awards.

Bowlers failing to appear at scheduled times and are unable to be rescheduled will forfeit their entry fees.

#### 8. OPTIONAL EVENTS

#### A. HANDICAP ALL EVENTS

The entry fee must be paid prior to an entrant's FIRST participation in the tournament.

#### **B. SCRATCH EVENTS**

The appropriate entry fees must be paid prior to an entrant's FIRST participation in the tournament. Prize winnings will be based on ACTUAL scores. Doubles entries remain with Entry # & Pair # regardless of substitutions.

#### C. BRACKETS

Individual Brackets - Handicap & Scratch, Maximum 10 Will be available in each of the Events.

Must collect bracket payout before you leave.

#### 9. AWARDS

Awards and Complementary Dinners at the Banquet of Champions (for each individual champion) will be presented to: HANDICAP Champions (Divisions 1 & 2):

Team, Singles, Doubles and All Events <u>ACTUAL</u> Champions (Divisions 1 & 2): Team, Singles, Doubles and All Events

### Twin Cities USBC \* \* TEAM ALL EVENTS AWARD \* \*

Team All Events Champion is the Team having the highest total Scratch Scores (Team – Doubles - Singles) of each of the five players. Championships will be awarded in both Divisions 1 & 2.

#### 10. OTHER ITEMS

Any tournament game or frames irretrievably lost due to the malfunction of an automatic scorer may be re-bowled, upon approval of tournament management.

Violation of any USBC or tournament rules will result in forfeiture of entry fees and prize winnings.

The Twin Cities USBC Association will be responsible for refund of entry fees only in the event the tournament is prematurely terminated due to causes beyond its control. Prizes will be pro-rated based on the number of participants that have bowled as of that date.
