Official Rules

- 1.) <u>Participation</u> This tournament is open to all youth bowlers 18 years of age or under. See bowl.com/youth for more information. All bowlers must be a member of the USBC. USBC information is how averages will be verified. If no USBC information or current league information those bowler will enter at scratch. It is the players responsibility to provide entering average information. NO ADULTS Allowed.
- 2.) <u>Squads & Times</u>—The tournament will run March 2nd through March 17th, 2024. There will be 10 shifts to choose from. Bowlers can bowl as many times as they wish, but can only cash once. Squads will be on a first-come-first-serve basis. Advanced reservations strongly encouraged, but walk-ins are welcome. Each squad has room for about 64 entries per squad.

Check-in - Bowlers should check-in 30 minutes prior to their scheduled shift. Bowlers will receive zero for any missed frames.

- 3.) <u>Entries & Entry fee</u> The entry fee is \$20.00 per bowler. \$10 goes toward bowling lineage (tax included), \$10 goes toward the AWARDS of the tournament for additional prizes such as high games and series. Entries will be accepted until 1:30pm on Sunday March 17th, 2024 (the last squad of the tourney). In the event a squad wills up the first PAID entries will be guaranteed a spot.
- 4.) Reservations Advanced reservations are strongly encouraged. You can reserve your spot by -

Again walk-ins are welcome. If your have a large group or people you would like to bowl with, PLEASE note that on the email or on the registration form. House will determine lane assignments.

5.) <u>Bowler Divisions</u> - The tournament has been divided into 2 separate divisions based by bowling average. Each division will have both boys and girls bowling together in the same division, however payouts will be separate for both boys and girls in each division. Divisions are listed as follows:

Division #1 (199 or less) Division #2 (200 & Above)

- **6.)** <u>Format</u> All bowlers will bowl three (3) regular American 10pin games on a single pair. There will be no moving to different pairs of lanes. The lanes will be dressed with the house shot prior to practice time. There will 4 bowlers max per lane—8 per pair. House will determine lane assignments. Bowlers can bowl as many times as they wish but can only cash once.
- 7.) <u>Handicap & Scoring</u> This tournament is handicapped. The handicap formula is 100% of 230, meaning if you entering average is 189, you would received 41 pins of handicap per game. The max score is not capped. Players can score a 300 game plus handicap.
- 8.) <u>Entering Averages</u> Bowlers will enter at last season's **HIGHEST** USBC book average which is the 2022-2023 league season. A 21 game minimum requirement is required to have a valid average from last season. If no book average at all, a bowler may enter with the current season's average providing that they have a minimum of 21 games and have a copy of the league standing sheet <u>present at check in</u> to back up their claim. If no book average at all or valid proof of current average, those bowlers will enter scratch which is 230. All bowlers will have their average verified. It is the bowler's responsibility to provide proof of average. If average can not be verified then that bowler will enter as scratch. Any <u>false</u> reporting of averages will result in automatic disqualification from the tournament and forfeiture of entry fee and prize winnings. **10 pin rule in effect!**. This tournament is NOT sanctioned.
- 9.) <u>Tournament Prize money</u> The tournament will payout in a ratio of 1 in 3. \$10,000 will be guaranteed to be paid out in youth scholarship funds. Each division will have separate winners for both boys and girls guaranteeing the top prize for each divisions for both boys and girls \$1,000 for first place. In the event of a tie, the prizes for the positions affected are to be equally divided. All money paid out will be through the tournaments SMART account #8716. In addition, there will be separate scholarship funds for both high games and series.
- **10.)** <u>Bowler Conduct</u> All bowlers must conduct themselves in a professional manner while competing. Please respect the bowling center, equipment, and staff. Please keep a steady pace of play. Any violations may result in disqualification.
- 11.) By signing up for this tournament, paid or unpaid, is an acknowledgement that you have read, understood, and will abide by the rules. All general playing rules of USBC will be in effect. Any rules not covered in these tournament rules will be governed by the most current USBC rule book. The decision of the tournament directors will be final for all other matters.
