# **Qualifications: Superior Performance – Active**

A candidate must be at least 40 years of age, a member of the Association for at least 15 years as an adult with a minimum of 54 games per year in a league in the Twin Cities USBC Association (including Greater St Paul Bowling Association, Minneapolis Men's Bowling Association, Minneapolis Women's Bowling Association, Minneapolis USBC Association, St Paul Women's Bowling Association or St Paul USBC Association). A candidate must have an outstanding record in City, State and National Tournaments. This is limited to bowlers who are still active in tournament and league play.

A minimum of 150 (men) or 125 (women) points is needed for consideration to the Hall of Fame.

# **Qualifications: Superior Performance – Pioneer**

A candidate must be at least 50 years of age and meets the above requirements and may or may not still be active in tournament and league play.

A minimum of 125 (men) or 100 (women) points is needed for consideration to the Hall of Fame.
