# Rules for Youth-Adult Tournament

## **“Six Divisions for payouts: Boy(3div.) and Girl(3div.)”**

Scratch Division 180 & up

Hdcp. Division 179-140

Hdcp. Division 139 and under. Divisions are determined by the youth bowler’s average.

**Using current 23-24 averages for this tournament. Please bring in your standing sheet or digital showing your highest youth or adult average as of April 6<sup>th</sup> 2024. If your league ended before April it would be your last standing sheet for your season 23-24.**

Brackets are available for youth and adults for \$3 each. Brackets will be hdcp. based on 90% of 210. All money the adult wins will go to their youth partner that shift in the form of scholarship money. (Adults go against adults and youth bowlers go against youth) Adult bowlers with no book average will not be able to enter brackets) Scholarship money from brackets will be enhanced using unassigned funds

### **NOTE:**

You will not automatically be placed in the scratch division. If you wish to bowl scratch you must declare it on the entry form or inform tournament staff when you check in. If not declared you will be put in the division your average places you in.

**Closing date for entries: May 19, 2024, 3:30PM**

**Scholarships will be awarded 1 in 3 in each division.** Bowlers may only place once in scholarship position. Scholarship awarded will be highest finish.

**NOTE:** Youth bowlers are eligible for only ONE scholarship of the highest payout regardless of different partners.

**Exceptions:** You are eligible to win unlimited times in the drawings from each shift of the tournament but only once in each shift. Unlimited times in brackets entered each shift.

**High Actual Series Scholarships(in each division)** – Six - First place (3)boys & (3)girls and Six - Second place (3)boys & (3)girls who bowl the highest ACTUAL series of the tournament in their division.

**High Actual Game Scholarships(in each division)** – Six - First place (3)boys & (3)girls and Six - Second place (3)boys & (3)girls who bowl the highest ACTUAL single game of the tournament in their division.

**High Actual Game Over Average Scholarship(in each division)** – Six - First place (3)boys & (3)girls and Six - Second place (3)boys & (3)girls who bowl highest ACTUAL single game over their average of the tournament in their division.

**Brackets available @ \$3.00 each:** Youth brks. & Adult brks., with adult winnings going to their youth partner in scholarship money. **(100% payback in scholarships)** No limit on how many brackets won.

**Handicap based on 90% of 420scratch** for each team.  
2 bowlers = one team which consist of one youth & one adult bowler.

**USBC Youth & Adult Tournament & Smart Scholarship program.** All **Youth** bowlers must hold current membership card. Adult Non-members will pay a Participation fee of \$5 for men or women, which is good only for this tournament. All tournament and USBC rules will be strictly adhered to.

All winners avg. will be verified. (Exception: Adults may use your USBC 22-23 BOOK Avg if not bowling this season. You will be required to pay the additional \$5 participation fee before bowling.) Rules 319a, 319b, 319c, 319d, & 319e will be in effect for all adult bowlers and posted at the sign in table. Falsification of averages will mean immediate disqualification.

Adult bowlers with no average this statement applies to you only. Once you complete bowling your first three games the tournament official will give you an average. This average will stay for the entire tournament. Adult not sanction remember will also be required to pay an additional \$5 before bowling.
