# TWIN CITIES USBC ASSOCIATION YOUTH CHAMPIONSHIPS

## APPROXIMATELY \$4,000 IN SCHOLARSHIPS

**At least One award for every Five entries in Each Division of Team, Doubles, Singles Events.**

### 1. ELIGIBILITY

All entrants must be certified members of USBC Youth.  
USBC eligibility 17b (Rule 400) applies.  
Proper dress code will be enforced.

### 2. AVERAGES

#### **Highest Standard or Adjusted Sport League Average Shall Be Used**

All bowlers will use their highest 2024-25 book average, based on a minimum of 15 games.

If no book average is available, they shall use their current average as of January 1, 2026. Those bowlers not having 15 games as of that date, will use their average as of the date 15 games are obtained. That date must be prior to the first date of an individual's competition. All others will bowl scratch.

#### **10 Pin Rule Will Be In Effect**

If a bowler's current average is 10 pins or higher than the previous season's average, as of January 1, 2026, the bowler must use their current league average.

### 3. AVERAGE VERIFICATION

All averages must be verified by a league coach, bowling proprietor or league secretary where the bowler's highest league average is achieved.

*I.E. A bowler enters the tournament with a team from Cedarvale Lanes, but has a higher average in the Travelling league; the Travelling League average shall be used.*  
A mother or father cannot verify a bowler's average, unless they are one of the aforementioned. The person verifying these averages must sign the reverse side of this form. **A copy of the league standing sheet as of January 1, 2026 (including the games bowled on that date) must be submitted for every league in which the bowlers participate.**

### 4. HANDICAP/SCRATCH

Handicap will be 90% with no limit.

Scratch will be based on the "group" concept – 840 for Team, 420 for Doubles, 210 for Singles and All Events

#### **For BUMPER Bowlers Only**

Entering average will be as of Jan 1, 2026, minimum of 12 games  
Scratch 125, 90% Handicap - No Limit. **Bumper to Regular Bowler will use current season average minimum 12 games**

### 5. EVENTS

Teams will consist of 4 players. Teams will be placed in the appropriate division based on the combined averages of the bowlers on the team.

**Multiple entries are allowed in the Team Event  
with a change of at least two bowlers**

Combined averages of the doubles participants will determine their division. **Bowlers entering the Doubles Event must also enter the Singles Event.** A bowler may bowl only the Singles Event. If bowling both Doubles and Singles, bowlers will bowl Doubles first and then bowl Singles. If bowling just Singles, bowlers will bowl Singles first and then be done.

**Bowlers may bowl only Once in the  
Singles and Doubles Events**

Any gender combination may bowl as Doubles Partners.

### 6. DIVISIONS

#### **TEAM EVENT**

(Divisions Based on Team Averages)

"A" – 675 & Over

"B" – 500 – 674

"C" – 499 & Under

#### **DOUBLES EVENT**

"A" – 335 & Over

"B" – 270 - 334

"C" – 220 - 269

"D" – 219 & Under

#### **SINGLES EVENT**

(Divisions Based on Individual Averages)

"A" – 175 & Over

"B" – 150 - 174

"C" – 120 – 149

"D" – 80 - 119

"E" – 79 & Under

#### **SINGLES for BUMPER BOWLERS**

This event is available to Bumper League Bowlers only.  
Each entrant will roll **two** games.

### 7. ALL EVENTS

All bowlers entering all three events (Team, Doubles and Singles) may enter into All Events for Scratch and/or Handicap.

The All Events divisions will be Scratch and Handicap for Males and Females. An Individual may enter Scratch and Handicap but may qualify for only ONE All Events Scholarship Award.

### 8. SCHOLARSHIPS

Scholarships will be awarded to at least ONE out of FIVE entries in the Team, Doubles, Singles and All Events.

#### **BUMPER EVENT**

Bumper bowlers will receive trophies only (1:5 ratio)

### 9. SUBSTITUTIONS/LINE-UPS

All bowlers are to report 30 minutes before they are scheduled to bowl. Line-ups as submitted must be adhered to, except in cases where substitutions must be made. A substitution must bowl in the position vacated. The captain or a coach is the only person authorized to request a change. No vacancy or blind scores are permitted.

There will also be a random draw of Saturday bowlers and Sunday bowlers of bowlers who did not receive a scholarship for another accomplishment in the tournament in the amount of \$50.00 for one boy and one girl in each of the drawings.

### 12. GERT FINKE SCHOLARSHIPS – NEW HOPE BOWL DONATION

Scholarships will be awarded to the doubles team with the highest scratch score in each of the 4 divisions in the amount of \$100.00/\$50.00 each.
